We would like to take an opportunity to provide you with information about our amazing band program at CPMS. Next year, 6th grade students will have the opportunity to participate as a member of the CPMS Beginning Band. Band is more than just playing an instrument; it is immersing your child in a culture of successful students and teachers who care about education. It challenges each child to use the creative side of his/her brain while, at the same time, learning a new language ... MUSIC.

Band is offered as a full year class that meets everyday. Participation in band does not conflict with athletics, clubs, or any other extra curricular activities. In a recent survey, over $72 \%$ of students that participate in band and choir are an athlete or participate in other clubs or activities. Students who choose to participate in the band will have FIT each day as well as their other classes. Students will need to choose between Band, Choir, or a related arts rotation. Students will have related arts in $7^{\text {th }} / 8^{\text {th }}$ grade in addition to their participation in band or choir. All interested students should sign up at this time.
